

Casemodders and YouTubers compete together

At the 15th anniversary of the International German Casemod Championship professional Casemodders create artworks in collaboration with YouTubers for a good cause.

Sparks will literally fly at the International German Casemod Championship (DCMM) when gamescom in cologne opens its doors from 17th to 21st August 2016. True to the motto "YouTube goes Casemodding", video bloggers create concepts with longstanding Pro-Casemodders cooperatively for this year's 24h Livemodding-Challenge. In hall 10.2 the YouTubers will be live on site when the six teams will put their ideas into action.

Casemodding for charity

In order to present their lavishly designed exhibits the international casemodding scene is brought together at DCMM for 15 years now. This calls for a celebration: At DCMM 2016 various YouTube channels and Pro-Modders are set up in a team and compete against each other at gamescom in Cologne. During the 24h Livemodding-Challenge standard cases turn into individual artworks within the first three days of gamescom. There is no given theme as this is defined freely by the Pro-Modders and the YouTubers in cooperation with their subscribers. A charity campaign will top off the 15th anniversary – for the first time all six teams provide their exhibits for a good cause.

At the final award ceremony at 21st August, 4:15pm in Hall 10.2 the participants of the 24h Livemodding-Challenge will announce for which organization they want to collect money. The spectacular creations will be raffled among all donors.

The Case-Catwalk

Last year's motto "Germany's prettiest beauty case" has left a deep impression on female artists. Again DCMM welcomes female participants. Furthermore four winners of the MSI PRO MOD Season 4 Challenge received wildcards for the participation at DCMM 2016 and do not need the jury's admission.

Parallel about 50 exhibits will be displayed and evaluated by a jury, consisting of experts from the modding-scene, at the weekend. These five categories will be evaluated: **CaseMod** (Case Modification), **CaseCon** (Case Construction), **CE-Mod** (Consumer Electronics), **24h Livemodding-Challenge** and
